**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF BERKELEY,
COUNTY OF OCEAN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY,
AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING CHAPTER II,
ENTITLED "ADMINISTRATION"**

SECTION 1. Chapter 2 of the Township Code of the Township of Berkeley, entitled "Administration," is hereby amended and supplemented so as to repeal §2-2.5 entitled "Removal of Municipal Officers."

SECTION 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision, and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions hereof.
