

ORDINANCE NO. 2025 -51 -OAB

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF BERKELEY, COUNTY OF OCEAN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, CREATING SECTION 26-5 ENTITLED "RECREATION PROGRAM SOUVENIR FEES" IN CHAPTER XXVI ENTITLED "BEACHES AND RECREATIONAL AREAS"

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Township Council of the Township of Berkeley, County of Ocean, and State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 26-5 of the Township Code, entitled "Recreation Program Souvenir Fees", from Chapter 26 entitled "Beaches and Recreational Areas" of the Township Code is hereby created, to read as follows:

§26-5. Recreation Program Souvenir Fees.

In coordination with Township Recreation-sponsored events, the Recreation Department is authorized to sell souvenirs commemorating the event, at a rate of \$5-\$25 per item, to be set by resolution of the Governing Body.

SECTION 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision, and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions hereof.


SECTION 4. This ordinance shall take effect after second reading and publication as required by law.
