

ORDINANCE NO. 2026-01-OAB

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF BERKELEY, COUNTY OF OCEAN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, AMENDING THE TOWNSHIP CODE, SO AS TO AMEND CHAPTER VII, ENTITLED "TRAFFIC" §7-10.1, ENTITLED "STOPPING OR STANDING PROHIBITED" (KORMAN ROAD)

January 1, 2026

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Township Council of the Township of Berkeley, County of Ocean, and State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter VII of the Township Code of the Township of Berkeley, entitled "Traffic," is hereby amended so as to amend §7-10.1, entitled "Stopping or Standing Prohibited," to include the roadway listed below which shall read as follows:

§7-10.1 STOPPING OR STANDING PROHIBITED.

No person shall stop or stand a vehicle upon any of the streets or parts of the streets described, except where other parking regulations have been provided for.

SECTION 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision, and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions hereof.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall take effect after second reading and publication as required by law.
