**ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF BERKELEY, COUNTY OF OCEAN,

WHEREAS, the Township of Berkeley holds title to the properties offered for sale at the auction by Max Spann on December 20, 2021; and

WHEREAS, at the time, place and date set for the receipt of bids for the sale of the subject properties, the individuals listed below submitted the highest bids to Max Spann; and

WHEREAS, the governing body accepted the bids submitted via Ordinance No. 2022-03-OAB; and

WHEREAS, the sale of Block 1392, Lots 1, 2-4, 6, 8, 10, 18, 20, 22 & 24 to the successful bidder was authorized via said ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the successful bidder defaulted and the Township wishes to sell the property to the next bidder, ALC Investment Trust; and

WHEREAS, the Township approves of said arrangement and authorizes the sale pursuant to the terms of the contract of sale to ALC Investment Trust at an amount of \$61,600.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Township Council of the Township of Berkeley, County of Ocean, State of New Jersey, as follows:

1. That the governing body does hereby authorize the sale of Block 1392, Lots 1, 2-4, 6, 8, 10, 18, 20, 22 & 24 to ALC Investment Trust in the amount of \$61,600.00.
2. That the Mayor and Township Clerk are hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the transfer of the subject properties to the individuals set forth herein in accordance with the terms of the notice to bidders for the sale of said properties.
3. That a certified copy of this resolution be forwarded to the Chief Financial Officer.
