

ORDINANCE NO. 2021-14-OAB

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF BERKELEY, COUNTY OF OCEAN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, AMENDING THE TOWNSHIP CODE, SO AS TO AMEND VARIOUS SECTIONS OF CHAPTER VII, ENTITLED "TRAFFIC" (BUTLER BLVD. EXIT TO BAYVIEW AVENUE)

April 26, 2021

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Township Council of the Township of Berkeley, County of Ocean, and State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter VII of the Township Code of the Township of Berkeley, entitled "Traffic," is hereby amended so as to amend §7-18, entitled "One Way Streets," to include Butler Boulevard, which shall now be as follows:

§7-18 One Way Streets.

The following streets or parts of streets are hereby designated as one-way streets in the direction indicated. Parking on these streets will be permitted on the sides indicated below.

Name of Street	Direction	Limits	Parking Permitted

Butler Blvd	South	The exit ramp from Butler Blvd. to Bayview Avenue on the South East corner of the intersection.	No Parking allowed

SECTION 2. Chapter VII of the Township Code of the Township of Berkeley, entitled "Traffic," is hereby amended so as to amend §7-22, entitled "Yield Intersections," to include the intersection of Butler Boulevard and Bayview Avenue, which shall now be as follows:

§7-22 Yield Intersections.

Pursuant to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 39:4-140, the intersections described are hereby designated as yield intersections. Yield signs shall be installed as provided herein.




SECTION 5. This ordinance shall take effect after second reading and publication as required by law.
