

ORDINANCE NO. 2025-20-OA B

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF BERKELEY, COUNTY OF OCEAN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY,
AMENDING THE TOWNSHIP CODE, SO AS TO AMEND CHAPTER VII, ENTITLED "TRAFFIC" MULTI-WAY STOP INTERSECTION)

April 21, 2025

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Township Council of the Township of Berkeley, County of Ocean, and State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter VII of the Township Code of the Township of Berkeley, entitled "Traffic," is hereby amended so as to amend §7-21, entitled "MULTI-WAY STOP INTERSECTIONS," to include various streets, which shall now include the following:

§ 7-21 MULTI-WAY STOP INTERSECTIONS.


Pursuant to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 39:4-140, the intersections herein described are designated as Multi-Way Stop Intersections. Stop signs shall be installed as provided herein.


<i>Intersection</i>	<i>Stop sign(s) on</i>

SECTION 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision, and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions hereof.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall take effect after second reading and publication as required by law.
